

FAMILY PLANNING IN NEVADA

The Account for Family Planning (AFP) was established by the Nevada Legislature in 2019 in support of reproductive health activities outlined in Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 442.710 to 442.745. AFP is administered by the Division of Public and Behavioral Health (DPBH) and provides funding to local partners who offer comprehensive sexual and reproductive health services to Nevadans who otherwise would be unable to obtain them. Through program funds, individuals can receive:

- Educational information regarding family planning.
- A large variety of birth control information and supplies.
- Referral to appropriate agencies for preconceptions services and assistance in achieving pregnancy.
- Testing and treatment of sexually transmitted infections (STI).
- Any vaccinations recommended by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices of the Centers of Disease Control and Prevention of the United States Department of Health and Human Services.
