Maternal, Infant and Early Childhood Home Visiting (MIECHV) is a free service offered to support positive parenting and healthy child development. The goal of the MIECHV program is to teach parents and give them the tools they need to prepare their child for school. People who are pregnant or have a child up to age five may voluntarily request these in-home services. In addition to teaching and coaching, home visitors also provide access to community resources to help create a healthy family dynamic and economic stability.
