


REQUEST NOT TO ADOPT UPDATED VACCINATION RECOMMENDATIONS

[Nevada Administrative Code \(NAC\) 441A.200\(1\)](#) provides a list of public health recommendations, guidelines, and publications that are adopted by reference and provides the most recent version each is deemed adopted by reference.

Subsection 2 of NAC 441.200, provides an exception to this rule “if both state and local health authorities determine that an update of or revision to a recommendation, guideline or publication. . . is not appropriate for use in the State of Nevada.” In this case, the Chief Medical Officer will present the group’s determination to the Board of Health, and the update or revision will not be adopted.

The Division of Public and Behavioral Health, along with the local health districts (Southern Nevada Health District, Northern Nevada Health District, and the Central Nevada Health District) unanimously request the Board of Health not to adopt by reference the most recent version of the *General Recommendations on Immunization: Recommendation of the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices (ACIP)*, as referenced in subsection 1.(c)(1). The state and local health authorities further request that revisions to these recommendations made since June 24, 2025, not be adopted by reference. Therefore, the version of the ACIP recommendations as of June 24, 2025, will remain the reference in regulation until the state and local public health authorities make a formal request to the Board of Health to adopt a newer version.
