1. Roll Call

Roll call was taken and determined a quorum of the Advisory Council on the State Program for Wellness, and the Prevention of Chronic Disease (CWCD) was present, per Nevada Revised Statute (NRS) 439.518

2. Public Comment

Vice Chair Dr. Amber Donnelli noted that members of the public may speak for public comment.

Vice Chair Donnelli noted no comments made.

3. Approve Minutes from the August 18th, 2022 Meeting

Vice Chair Donnelli asked if there were any corrections to the minutes from the August 18th, 2022 meeting.

None heard.

Chris Needham made a motion to approve the minutes. Cari Harrington seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

4. Possible Action to Recommend New Board Members for Appointment

Vice Chair Donnelli opened discussion to recommend new board members for appointment to include one (1) Registered Dietician and one (1) representative of the health industry.

Lily Helzer confirmed a received application for the Registered Dietician seat and stated there were no applications for the second seat.

Dr. Steve Shane motioned to appoint Kagan Griffin as a new board member to fill the seat of the Registered Dietician. Dr. Ihsan Azzam seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.

5. Present CDPHP Section & Program Update

Ms. Helzer presented the Chronic Disease and Health Promotion updates on the five-year strategic plan.

Ms. Helzer noted efforts being made to better integrate primary prevention through the section, improve evaluation processes for all parties, and new grant forecasts for several programs.

Ms. Helzer directed members to see the CDPHP Section Update document for more information on specific programs. (CDPHP Section Updates 11.10.22)

6. Present Local Health Authority CDPHP Program Reports

Vice Chair Donnelli introduced Maria Azzarelli to provide updates and give a program report for Southern Nevada Health District. (Combined Local Health Authority Updates)

Ms. Azzarelli noted an increase in attendance to the self-management education class pertaining to diabetes and queried if recording the classes would be appropriate to accommodate the increased interest in the self-management education courses.

Ms. Azzarelli stated query must be discussed further within the SNHD team.

Ms. Harrington requested elaboration on the operation of the fresh produce stand and requested more information on how members can partner with SNHD for collaborative efforts.

Ms. Azzarelli explained that SNHD is working with a local partner such as Together We Can, to bring fruits and vegetables to community members, which is purchased from a licensed mobile unit at a lower cost.

Ms. Azzarelli mentioned that grant funding is used, and the costs associated with the produce stands is something to consider when discussing possible partnership.

Vice Chair Donnelli asked for any questions or comments.

None heard.

Vice Chari Donnelli introduces Stephanie Chen to give the Washoe County Health District update. Ms. Chen stated the report can be found in the combined program updates and opened the floor for discussion and questions.

None heard.

Vice Chair Donnelli introduced Nicki Aaker, Director of Carson City Health and Human Services and acting manager for the Chronic Disease Division.

Ms. Aaker presented updates on the Adolescent Health Education Program, outreach events, and the estimated one-year long project to covert Carson City Health and Human Services into a trauma informed care agency.

Ms. Aaker referred members to https://gethealthycarsoncity.org/tobacco/ for additional information on the tobacco industry.

Ms. Aaker opened the floor for questions.

None heard.

Vice Chair Donnelli introduced Ashley Gurr who provided the Elko County update.

Ms. Gurr mentioned the community outreach efforts being made in Elko County.

Vice Chair Donnelli opened the floor to queries.

Brooke Conway spoke on behalf of Amanda Haboush-Deloye to give the update for Nevada Institute of Children's Research and policy.

Vice Chair Donnelli called for any questions.

None heard.

7. For Action- Kidney Disease Task Force as Subcommittee of CWCD

Vice Chair Donnelli referred members to the meeting packet for more information on the election of members for possible action to include members of the CWCD.

Ms.Helzer confirmed there are applications in the meeting packet for the board to look at and decide if there is a qualified candidate to add to the Kidney Disease Task Force Subcommittee.

Ms. Helzer noted it is up to the discretion of this board to determine if the applicants are qualified for the positions.

Dr. Donnelli asked if any members of the board would like the candidates to leave the forum before discussion begins.

No oppositions heard.

Dr. Donnelli asked if there are any questions for the applicants.

None heard.

Dr. Donnelli confirmed board members reviewed the resumes and information included in the packet.

Dr. Donnelli consults Ms. Helzer to locate information on the candidate Joe Ferreira.

Ms. Helzer explained no resume was received for Mr. Ferreira and the application can be tabled if the board prefers to see a resume.

Dr. Donnelli recommended this action be postponed due to insufficient amount of information and entertains a motion to do so in lieu of waiting for a resume.

Tina Dortch motioned to table the application. Dr. Shane seconds the motion, which then passed unanimously.

Vice Chair Donnelli asked for further discussion regarding the other two candidates, Dr. Lawrence Lehrner and Rocko Graziano.

None heard.

Dr. Donnelli made a motion for approval. Ms. Helzer requests clarification on the motion of approval.

Dr. Donnelli responded the motion is to proceed with one applicant at a time.

Ms. Azzarelli moved to approve Dr. Lerner. Dr. Azzam seconded the motion, which then passed unanimously.

Dr. Donnelli asked for any oppositions.

None heard.

Dr. Azzam motions to approve Rocco Graziano's application. Dr. Shane seconds the motion, which then passes unanimously.

Dr. Donnelli welcomed both individuals to the board with hopes of recruitment efforts to fill other vacancies.

8. Call to Order/Roll Call

Vice Chair Donnelli stated the next section of the meeting will proceed to the Kidney Disease Task force and confirmed with Ms. Helzer that roll needed to be recalled.

Emily Sanchez reestablished quorum by calling roll and determined a quorum of the Advisory Council was present.

9. Public Comment

Vice Chair Donnelli opened the floor for public comments. None heard.

10. Discussion and Possible Recommendations Regarding Council's Role in Increasing Education

Vice Chair Donnelli asked for any board members that can speak to the topic.

None heard.

Dr. Donnelli invited Mr. Graziano to speak about increasing education regarding kidney disease.

Mr. Graziano mentioned the need for more education to primary care providers and more information available to underserved populations, in order to diagnose kidney diseases at a faster rate than what is currently being done.

11. Informational

Dr. Donnelli asked for additional conversation from the board to develop key areas when discussing future agenda items.

Ms. Dortch mentioned the disproportionate effect this subject matter has on underserved communities and suggested rethinking how outreach is conducted in Nevada communities.

Mr. Graziano responded in agreement with Ms. Dortch that more work needed to be done which focuses on the African American and Hispanic populations.

Dr. Lehrner added the importance of education for the general population as well as the importance of educating physicians to identify patients as early as possible.

Ms. Dortch asked how this council could have someone show up in the community to increase outreach initiatives.

Mr. Graziano volunteered to assist in further developing documents and training manuals for educational and outreach purposes.

Dr. Lerner discussed the prevalence of diabetes and hypertension when screening for kidney disease and possible collaboration with DaVita Dialysis Chain to provide more education into the communities.

Dr.Azzam mentioned the importance of defining a mission, setting clear goals, and developing an action plan for field operations or outreach programs to serve patients and providers in Nevada communities.

Dr. Donnelli thanked the board members for contributing to the discussion.

12. Public Comment

Vice Chair Donnelli asked for public comment.

None heard.

13. Adjourn as Kidney Disease Task Force, Reconvene as CWCD

Dr. Azzam entertains a motion to adjourn the Kidney Task Force. Chris Needham seconds the motion, which passed unanimously.

14. Informational

Vice Chair Donnelli invited Ms. Helzer to complete recognition of outgoing board members.

Ms. Helzer thanked Stacy Briscoe and Chris Needham for many years on the Advisory Board and valuable input brought to the table by both individuals.

15. Public Comment

Vice Chair Donnelli asked for public comment to be made at this time.

Dr. Shane asked Ms. Helzer for more information on the kind of barriers that may be in place as it relates to enrollment in federally funded assistance programs.

Ms. Helzer offered to provide a more comprehensive overview as it pertains to the WIC program as well as other food service programs at a future meeting.

Dr. Donnelli called on Mitch DeValliere for public comment.

Dr. DeValliere recommended the board begin determining bylaws for the Kidney Disease Advisory Committee per Deputy Attorney General.

Dr. Donnelli asked for any additional public comment.

None heard.

Vice Chair Donnelli entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting. A motion to adjourn was made by Mr. Needham and seconded by Dr. Shane, which passed unanimously.
