Topic (2): NAC 458.xxx ABUSE OF ALCOHOL AND DRUGS

The Council may ask clarifying questions, discuss potential system-level implications, and consider whether to provide feedback, recommendations, or formal input regarding the proposed regulations.

6. FOR POSSIBLE ACTION: Strategic Plan – Advisory framework and implementation Discussion – Information and Discussion
