**3.)** Action Item: Approval of Policy Board Minutes for June 13<sup>th</sup>, 2022, and July 11<sup>th</sup>, 2022. Chair, Julia Ratti/Vice Chair, Steve Shell

Chair Ratti entertained a motion for the June 13 meeting minutes to be approved.

Ms. Sandy Stamates made the motion to approve.

Mr. Peter Ott seconded the motion.

The motion passed unanimously.

**4.) Action Item:** Discussion and Approval of Bill Draft Request concepts, based on presentations from previous policy board meetings of March 14, April 11, May 9, June 13, and July 11, 2022.

The Board discussed seven concepts:

- 1. **Community Health Workers (CHW)**: How to expand Medicaid reimbursement for CHWs and the supervision of behavioral health clinicians.
- 2. **Behavioral Health Workforce 1**: Addressing the shortage of providers and reviewing training, incentive programs which will be invested to increase graduates.
- 3. **Behavioral Health Workforce 2**: Creation of a common definition for clinical supervision which will align with accreditation standards of combined education bodies and licensing boards.
- 4. **Standards/Policies for Children's System of Care:** Establish in statute, the authority for the Department of Child and Family Services (DCFS) to establish standards for providers, allowing the development of a baseline/policies and monitor through certification.
- 5. Law Enforcement Diversion and Deflection: Propose specific policy modernizing language in NRS 458.175 around civil protective custody and come into line with existing standards of care.
- 6. Supportive and Other Housing for Very Low and Extremely Low-Income Nevadans: Increase the Real Property Transfer Tax to a new Deep Subsidy Account.
- 7. Collaborative Care Model for Substance Use Disorder (SUD): Legislation to support the Collaborative Care Model (CoCM) through turning on the Current Procedural Terminology (CPT) codes to cover CoCM; and supporting state implementation and system transformation to improve overall health outcomes, resolve health inequities and save costs.

After discussing each item, the Board selected to pursue for their Bill Draft Request, item number two, Behavioral Health Workforce 1.

Chair Ratti entertained a motion for approval of the BDR. The motion was seconded, and the Board passed the motion unanimously.
