# Challenges, Issues, or Barriers

## Project Challenges, Issues, or Barriers

### Opioid Data Dashboard –

- Ongoing changes to national standard around methodology.
  - Ongoing
  - Unavoidable
  - Maintainable

### Data Sharing between DHHS/DPS (Criminal History Repository) –

- Security Concerns
  - Resolved – a separate secure server was built on the DHHS side to store these data.

### Overdose Reporting under AB 474 – NAC 441A

- These reports are being received, but with some quality/completeness concerns.
- Auditing for completeness of reporting can only be confirmed retroactively.

# Priorities for Next Quarter

## Project

Complete WITS implementation and develop a communication plan for the requirement of reporting of statewide TEDS data.

- Data repository should be ready to accept data by end of April 2018.
- EHR should be ready for production end of May 2018.

Preliminary analyses of the Criminal History Repository.

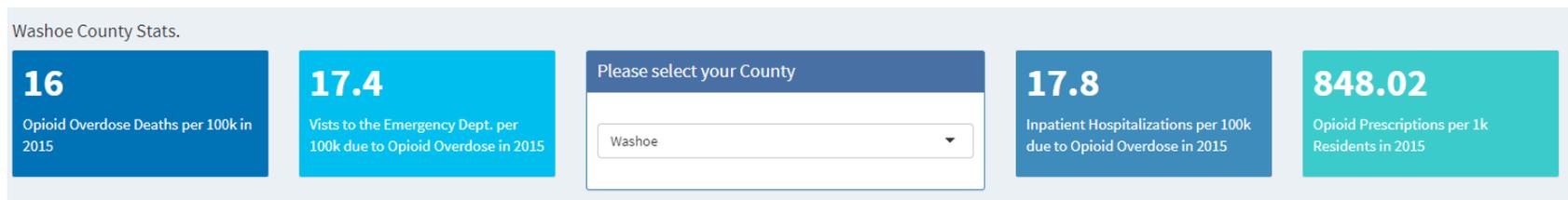
Preliminary analyses and surveillance of the overdose data reported in accordance with AB 474 – NAC 441A.

- Volume of overdoses reported by patient demographics, including regional analyses.
- We hope to have a Biostatistician position dedicated to opioid analyses filled by next quarter.
