Methods: Overdose visits were extracted from the Emergency Department Hospital Billing database. Visits were transposed to individuals by Social Security Number (SSN). Overdoses on "any drug" could include over the counter medication. For analysis, the drug type was limited to schedule 2, 3, 4 drugs, which the Drug Enforcement Administration (DEA) consider to be potentially habit forming and/or the potential for abuse.

Limitations: In 2016 and 2017 combined, there were over 2,000 missing social security numbers in the Emergency Department Hospital Billing Data.
